In addition to the information that we collect from you directly, we may also receive information about you from other sources, including third parties, business partners, our affiliates, publicly available sources or information that you disclose to us whose collection we did not intend.

Use And Processing Of Information.

In addition to the purposes and uses described above, we use information in the following ways:

- To identify you when you visit the Site.
- To improve the Site and our services and products.
- To conduct analytics.
- To respond to e-mail inquiries sent to us through the "Contact Us" email address listed on the Site.

- To send marketing and promotional materials, including information relating to our products, services, sales, or promotions.
- For internal administrative purposes, as well as to manage our relationships.
